

Stockdale Youth Group Summer 2019 Schedule Notes

- ❖ **It is very important that your Breeze Account information (address, phone number, email) is up to date! If your family does not currently have a Breeze account, please see me ASAP so we can set you up.** Breeze emails and text reminders are my primary form of contact with parents. Please get in the habit of checking your email regularly, if you are not already doing so. I will typically send you an email at least once a week about schedule updates (postponements, cancellations, etc.) and reminders.

- ❖ Vans will leave for Devo 2 Go at 6:45 and will return to the building by 9:15. You are more than welcome to drive your own vehicle, as you may live closer to a host family's home than you do to the building!

- ❖ Uplift registration deadline is May 31. I have registration instructions outside my office.

- ❖ Bandina registration ends June 26th. Early bird discount ends May 29th.
- ❖ Each student will be placed on one of three teams for the Summer. These teams will be used for the Summer Game Days and Service Project Days. (Team rosters will be emailed through Breeze, once compiled) Teams will create their own service project to complete during the summer.

These service projects will occur on separate days. (Ex. Team 1 goes on the first scheduled day, and so on.)

- ❖ We will be having three Summer Game Days, one per month. (6.22, 7.13, 8.03) Game Days will begin at 2 and end at 5 with a meal to follow.
- ❖ Because we will be eating together after our Game Days, we will not be having First Wednesday Fellowship Meals during the Summer. First Wednesday Fellowship Meals will resume in September.
- ❖ We will have dress-up theme nights throughout the Summer. The dates and themes are included in the Summer schedule.
- ❖ Prices and times for our three big “just for fun” outings (Drive-In, Baseball Game, and Six Flags) will be announced at a later date.
Disclaimer: Announced prices for the Baseball Game and Six Flags will be dependent upon group rates. Meaning, if we do not hit the minimum number of attendees to qualify for the group rate, the price per ticket will be higher than expected.
- ❖ Drive-In, Baseball Game, and Six Flags are open to the whole family. Teens will be given preference for van transportation to these events, but families may ride in the vans if space is available.
